**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER**

AND NOW, this 14<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2020, in accordance with the Pennsylvania Supreme Court's Declaration of a Judicial Emergency, it is hereby ORDERED that in regards to Preliminary Hearings scheduled through May 29, 2020, if the defendant has not been fingerprinted prior to his or her scheduled Preliminary Hearing, the following shall apply:

- 1) The defendant will be provided a prospective date certain at which time they will be required to appear at the Beaver County Regional Booking Center at the Beaver County Jail to be fingerprinted in accordance with the Criminal History Record Information Act, 18 Pa.C.S. §9112.
- 2) Regardless of the disposition of his or her case (even if dismissed), any defendant who fails to appear for fingerprinting as ordered shall be subject to being held in contempt of the fingerprint order.
