BEAVER COUNTY COMMISSIONERS TO OPEN NEW FOUR SEASONS PAVILION AND SCHEDULE EVENING PUBLIC MEETING AT THE PAVILION

(October 20, 2015-Beaver, PA)

Bradys Run County Park will be the site of two events for County government on Thursday afternoon, October 22, 2015.

In recognition of the official opening of the newly-constructed Four Seasons Pavilion at Bradys Run Park a ribbon-cutting is scheduled for 5 pm on October 22nd. The staff, consultants, contractors and labor representatives responsible for the project will join the Beaver County Board of Commissioners in viewing the new facility and officially opening it for public use. Special events have already been scheduled for the Pavilion.

Members of the general public are invited to attend the official opening of the Four Season Pavilion at 5 pm, in addition to remaining for the regularly scheduled 6 pm Public Meeting of the Board of Commissioners. The Commissioners' Public Meeting will mark the first official use of the Four Seasons Pavilion.

The Four Seasons Pavilion offers (1) a 2,500 square foot facility with outlets in roof beams for small lighting, (2) a main room [60 ft. x 30 ft] and a food services area [28 ft. x 9 ft] with radiant floor heating, (3) 6 ceiling fans, (4) a caterer's kitchen including a double-door refrigerator, sinks, numerous electrical outlets, stainless steel tables, and ADA compliant restrooms.

Member unions of the Beaver County Building Trades contributed to the construction of the facility under a Project Labor Agreement executed with the Board of Commissioners.

The Pavilion's construction totaled \$ 916,796.98., which includes a County investment of \$ 666,796.98. and a grant of \$ 250,000. from the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania's Department of Conservation & Natural Resources Bureau of Conservation &
