Until further notice, the public will no longer have physical access to the following County Offices and Departments:

- Planning/Redevelopment
- Recreation/Tourism
- Assessment/Tax Claim
- Children and Youth Services
- Coroner's Office
- Bureau of Elections
- Waste Management
- Treasurer's Office
- Controller's Office
- Community Development
- Behavioral Health
- Department of Public Works
- District Attorney's Office
- Office on Aging
- Beaver County Jail
- Commissioner's Office

Although not completely closed to the public, the following offices are also substantially restricting the access and services being offered:

- Central Services
- Register of Wills
- Clerk of Courts
- Law Library
- Public Defender
- Recorder of Deeds (by appointment)
- Prothonotary's Office
- Sheriff's Office (Gun permits made available only by appointment)
- Domestic Relations
- Adult Probation
- Juvenile Services
- Veterans' Affairs (DAV transportation still available)
- Court of Common Pleas (Parties should contact their attorneys before coming to court)

Any member of the public having business in any of these limited offices should ensure they contact that office prior to arriving at the Courthouse or other County Office. All members of the public will be screened by the Sheriff Deputies prior to obtaining entrance. The Sheriff's Deputies will turn away any individuals that are not adhering to these guidelines.

Beaver County requests residents to take advantage of the provided remote services that are available via online, telephone, or through the mail. Beaver County Officials are continually monitoring the situation and further instructions will be made when available.
