SENATOR IN THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY –46th Senatorial District – Vote for One, Municipalities Include: Frankfort Springs Boro, Hanover Twp, Independence Twp.

REPRESENTATIVE IN THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY – 14th Legislative District
