In accordance with the provisions of the Election Code notice is hereby given to the electors of Beaver County that a General Primary will be held on Tuesday, April 23, 2024 between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. prevailing time, for the nomination of candidates to the following offices:

ATTORNEY GENERAL
AUDITOR GENERAL
STATE TREASURER
REPRESENTATIVE IN CONGRESS 17TH DISTRICT
SENATOR IN THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY 47TH DISTRICT
REPRESENTATIVE IN THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, 14TH, 15TH & 16TH DISTRICTS**

The following are the party offices and number to be elected at the General Primary, April 23, 2024 in the 17th Congressional District:

- **SEVEN DEMOCRATIC DELEGATES TO THE NATIONAL CONVENTION**
Three Males and Four Females elected
- **THREE REPUBLICAN DELEGATES TO THE NATIONAL CONVENTION**
- **THREE REPUBLICAN ALTERNATE DELEGATES TO THE NATIONAL CONVENTION**

One Republican Committee Man and One Republican Committee Woman per election district will be voted on. In addition there are to be Republican Committee Members elected at Large in the following Municipalities – Beaver Borough (3); Big Beaver Borough (2); Brighton Township (6); Center Twp (3); Chippewa Township (8); Darlington Township (2); Daugherty Township (2); Economy Borough (7); Franklin Township (4); Greene Township (3); Hanover Township (3); Hopewell Township (2) Independence Township (3); Industry Boro (1); New Sewickley Township (7); North Sewickley Township (2); Ohioville Borough (3); Patterson Township (2); Raccoon Township (2); South Beaver Township (4).

Petitions to have the name of a candidate printed upon Official Primary ballots, which are to be filed in the office of the Beaver County Board of Elections in Beaver, Pennsylvania, must be filed in that office by 4:30 P.M., February 13, 2024. Casting of lots to determine the position of names on the ballot will be held on Friday, February 16, 2024 at 10:00 a.m. in the Bureau of Elections office.

For the purpose of casting lots, any candidate may appear in person or by proxy appointed in writing. The County Bureau of Elections shall cast lots for any candidate who does not appear.

The Beaver County Board of Elections will begin the pre-canvass of Absentee and Mail-in Ballots from the April 23, 2024 General Primary Election on Tuesday, April 23, 2024 at 7:00 a.m. in the multi-purpose room located in the basement of the Beaver County Courthouse. The Return Board will convene Friday, April 26, 2024 at 9:00 A.M. in the Multi-Purpose Room located in the basement of the Beaver County Courthouse, for the purpose of computing all votes cast at the April 23, 2024 General Primary Election and determining the eligibility of provisional ballots. Eligibility of any military or overseas ballots received after the deadline will be determined on Wednesday, May 1, 2024.
