## **Caregiver Support Program**

The Caregiver Support Program is designed to reduce caregiver stress and respond directly to the needs of **CAREGIVERS** of older adults, individuals with Alzheimer's Disease or other chronic dementia, as well as **Grandparents and other relatives** aged 55 and older who are raising grandchildren or caring for adults with disabilities.







The caregiver does **NOT GET PAID** for caregiving; rather, they receive **reimbursement** for preapproved out-of-pocket expenses.

Caregiver Support Program offers the following:

- Financial assistance through a cost sharing approach. Primary caregivers may receive reimbursement for out-of-pocket expenses such as personal care services, supplies, assistive devices, or home modifications and respite care when paying a **NON-RELATIVE**.
- Total household income determines the specific percentage of monthly reimbursement
- Assisting Caregivers in making decisions and solving problems relating to their caregiving roles, organizing support groups, and arranging for caregiving training
